Level 3 Award in Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment

Course Content

This qualification consists of one unit: Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment (Unit 301 D/601/5313). During this qualification you will develop the knowledge to understand the work of an assessor, and will cover:

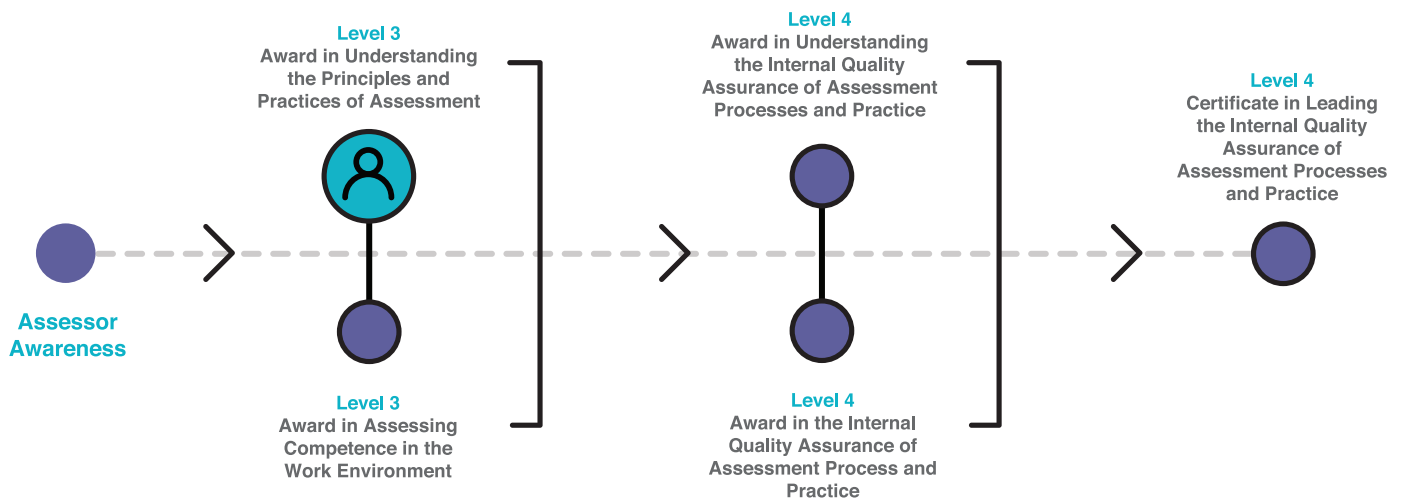
